Attached you will find a form to fill in, and a summary of the positions on the Society's Leadership Team. Each candidate must submit a brief profile plus a statement of interest for each position in which they are interested (a maximum of two positions).

On 7 November (a week before the Society's next Workshop) the slate of candidates, their profiles, and their expressions of interest will be distributed to the active members and posted on the Society's website. During the Workshop, the candidates will be presented to the members. Elections will be held using an Internet ballot beginning a week after the Annual Workshop and lasting for two weeks.

## Annual Workshop, November 16 and 17

The World Bank will host the 2016 DMDU workshop in Washington DC, on November 16 and 17, 2016, with a training on DMDU methodologies scheduled for November 15th, 2016. The Annual Workshop Committee (Laura Bonzanigo, Julie Rozenberg, Nidhi Kalra, Laurna Kaatz) has worked hard to organize a series of plenary talks, poster pitches and social activities alongside six major sessions:

- Bridging the False Divide: Are We Ignoring the Role of Adaptive Operations for Improving the Efficiency, Resilience and Robustness of Planned Infrastructure? Chaired by Pat Reed (Cornell University);
- 2. Deep Uncertainty and the Long-Term: Time, the policy challenge and enablers for policy persistence. Chaired by **Judy Lawrence** (New Zealand Climate Change Research Institute);
- Endogenising the 'exogenous': complex feedbacks in decision problems. Chaired by Jim Hall (University of Oxford);
- 4. DMDU Techniques in Practice Successes, Challenges, and What's to Come. Chaired by Laurna Kaatz (Denver Water);
- 5. Balancing Decision-making Needs Under Deep Uncertainty with Effective, High-Quality Integrated Systems Modeling. Chaired by **Jordan Fischbach** (RAND);
- 6. When poorly designed indicators lead to bad decisions. Chaired by **Stephane Hallegatte** (World Bank)
